

You are registered as a student to attend BLAST from January 20th - January 22nd @ Pheasant Run Resort in St. Charles.

Departure and Arrival Details:

- **Departure for South Barrington & Crystal Lake Students:** Check-in promptly @ **5:00pm on Friday, January 20th.** Go to Entrance D and check-in at the tables in the main lobby at Willow Creek, South Barrington. If you are leaving your car at the church, please park in the FAST TRACK parking lot. There will be a shuttle there to bring you over to Entrance E. After you check-in, place your luggage on your assigned luggage truck located at the Entrance D. Then come back inside to meet your small group in the Atrium. **DuPage, Huntley, and North Shore will NOT be departing from Willow Creek, South Barrington. For any additional information, please see your regional area website.**
- **Arrival for South Barrington & Crystal Lake:** Busses will return to Entrance F at approximately **3:00pm on Sunday January 22nd.**
- **DuPage:** Parents will drop their students off at "Lucky Piere's" at Pheasant Run on January 20 at 7pm. Parents will pick their students up from the main lobby at Pheasant Run on January 22nd at 1:30pm. Note: parents must drop off and pick up their students. Huntley: Meet at Huntley High School at 5:45pm on January 20th. Will arrive back at Huntley HS at 2:30pm on January 22.

(If you feel these will be a distraction at camp, leave them at home!)
